Extended international operations with the acquisition of a 100% interest in Hirslanden, the leading private hospital group in Switzerland, operating 13 private acute care facilities. This coincided with the 75th anniversary of the group's Klinik Hirslanden.

2008

Management and operating structure of the Group divided into three divisions -Hirslanden (Switzerland), Mediclinic Southern Africa (South Africa and Namibia) and Mediclinic Middle East (the United Arab Emirates).

Mediclinic's 25th anniversary is celebrated. Mediclinic Middle East (then Emirates Healthcare) opened Mediclinic Mirdif (then Welcare Clinic Mirdif) in Dubai.

2010

Mediclinic Southern Africa opened Mediclinic Cape Gate in Cape Town.

Hirslanden acquired Klinik Stephanshorn in St. Gallen, Switzerland.









International Integration Phase

2012

Acquired remaining minority interest in Mediclinic Middle East (then Emirates Healthcare), increasing its effective shareholding to 100%.

Operations in Dubai rebranded from Emirates Healthcare to Mediclinic.

2014

Mediclinic Middle East opened Mediclinic Corniche in Abu Dhabi.

Hirslanden acquired a 100% interest in the operating businesses of Clinique La Colline in Geneva and Swissana Clinic AG in Meggen, Lucerne.

Mediclinic Southern Africa opened Mediclinic Gariep in Kimberley, Northern Cape (operated jointly with the existing Mediclinic Kimberley).

Mediclinic listed on the Namibian Stock Exchange as a secondary listing.

2016

Successfully completed the combination of Mediclinic International Limited and Al Noor Hospitals Group plc by way of a reverse takeover of Mediclinic International Limited, resulting in the continued listing of the enlarged company on the London Stock Exchange and secondary listings on the JSE Ltd and the Namibian Stock Exchange.

Mediclinic Middle East acquired the remaining 25% interest in the Al Madar Group of clinics.

Hirslanden opened the outpatient clinic 'Praxiszentrum Düdingen'.

2013

Mediclinic Middle East acquired two pathology laboratories at Mediclinic Welcare Hospital and Mediclinic Al Sufouh in Dubai.

Mediclinic Southern Africa relocated and expanded Mediclinic Lephalale in Lephalale, Limpopo.

Hirslanden acquired main shareholding in Privatklinik Linde, a leading private hospital in Biel.

2018

Mediclinic Southern Africa acquired a controlling interest in Intercare's day hospitals.

Mediclinic Middle East opened Mediclinic Parkview Hospital, the largest greenfield construction project by value for the Group.

Hirslanden Clinique La Colline merged with Clinique des Grangettes, with Hirslanden holding a controlling majority share in the new company.

Mediclinic Middle East acquired Dubai-based City Centre Clinics Deira and Me'aisem from Maiid Al Futtaim.

Mediclinic Middle East acquired a minority stake in Bourn Hall International MENA Limited, the holding company for the Bourn Hall Fertility Centre in the UAE.

Mediclinic Southern Africa bought Welkom Medical Centre.

2020

Hirslanden acquired Operationzentrum Zumikon, one of Zurich's leading day case clinics.

Hirslanden entered into a collaboration agreement with Medbase, the leading Swiss specialist in family healthcare and part of the Migros Group, and subsequently sold its three outpatient clinics to Medbase.

Mediclinic Middle East formed a strategic partnership with the Al Murjan Group in Saudi Arabia, with the proposed establishment of a new acute care hospital in Jeddah.

Revival of Hirslanden Healthline during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Furthermore, Hirslanden opened the OPERA St.Gallen, a day case clinic.

Mediclinic Middle East entered into partnership with Dubai and Abu Dhabi governments to manage stand-alone quarantine facilities and a hospital during the COVID-19 pandemic.







2019

Mediclinic Southern Africa relocated Mediclinic Stellenbosch and opened Mediclinic Winelands Orthopaedic Hospital, in partnership with the Institute of Orthopaedics and Rheumatology in Stellenbosch.

Hirslanden disposed of Klinik Belair.

Hirslanden entered into public-private partnership with the University Hospitals of Geneva to establish day case clinic and with Kantonsspital Baselland for musculoskeletal disorder treatment.

Mediclinic Southern Africa acquired the specialised mental healthcare hospital Denmar.

Mediclinic Middle East opened Mediclinic Springs, a dedicated paediatric outpatient clinic.
